Spring Has Sprung! Home Maintenance Checklist

1. Exterior Inspection-Check roof, siding, gutters and downspouts for any damage or blockages from the winter. Check windows and doors to ensure there are no cracks or leaks. Check deck for loose boards.
2. Check HVAC System-This is the perfect time to change your filter and schedule a maintenance service.
3. Safety Check-Change batteries in smoke/carbon monoxide detectors. Replace if needed.
4. Reverse Ceiling Fans-Spring and Summer fans should go counter clockwise to create a downdraft.
5. Exterior Cleanup-Prune trees and shrubs, cleanup and refresh landscaping, prepare irrigation system.

GENERAL MANAGER'S MESSAGE

HH MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS

As the General Manager here at Heritage Hunt, I am often asked ... who manages what?

Per the Associations Governing Documents, the Board of Directors are ultimately responsible for the overall Management Operations of the community. However, the Governing Documents do allow the Board of Directors to contract for Professional Management services. Regarding the day-to-day operations, and due to the strict regulations placed upon planned communities per State Statute, the Board engaged Community Association Management Professionals (CAMP) on March 1, 2022 to manage the day-to-day operations of the Association. The services provided by CAMP, under its contractual Managing Agent Agreement with, and fiduciary duty to, the Association, include:

- Collection of Assessments, Club Accounts, and Miscellaneous Revenue
- Accounts Payable (Payment of all expenses)
- Budget Planning and Management
- Financial Reporting
- Resident Services (Excursions, Activities, etc.)
- Architectural Compliance
- Administrative Services (meeting preparation/scheduling/coordination, etc.)
- Resident Communications (Newsletter, Website, e-comm's, etc.)
- Manage Facility Operations (Clubhouse, Marsh Mansion, Fitness Center, etc.)
- Oversight of Service and Repair Contracts
- Oversight of Reserve and Other Major Projects
- 24/7 Emergency Call Services
- And more

In addition to the services provided by CAMP as the Associations Managing Agent, the Association does contract for management of specialized services when needed including:

- Golf and Course Management Operations (Reports directly to Board)
- Food & Beverage Management Operations (Reports directly to Board)
- Indoor/Outdoor Pool Management Operations (Reports directly to CAMP)

- Front Gate Management Operations (Reports directly to CAMP)
- Landscape Service Management Operations (Reports directly to CAMP)
- Delinquent Account Collections (Reports directly to CAMP)

Although the Management responsibilities are contractually assigned as indicated, the Association also has many volunteer committee members who, among other assignments from the Board, assist the Board and Management by continuously evaluating the services provided to Residents and offering scope of service recommendations that they feel will best serve the community and its Residents.

The Golf Spring Mixer is April 5. Whether you're a golfer or not, the Pro Shop has Heritage Hunt

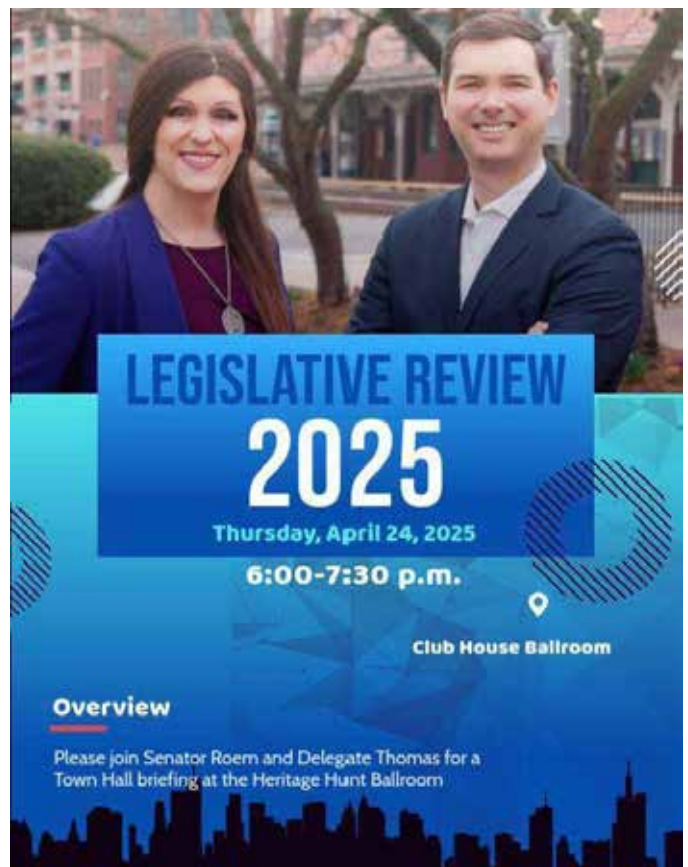
merchandise if you're looking for a gift for yourself or someone else.

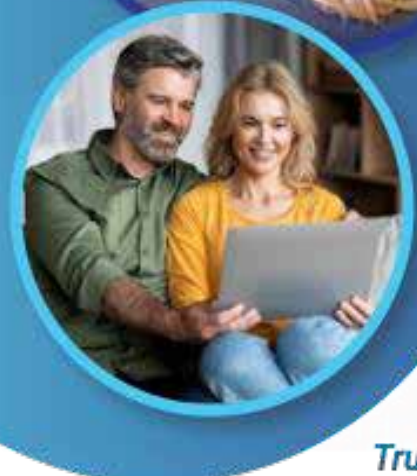

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS COMMITTEE

EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS TO RESIDENTS

In the event of an impending natural disaster, such as tornadoes or hurricanes, or dangerous situations resulting from man-made accidents or disasters, Heritage Hunt has the capability to notify all registered members via our “T-Communicator” System. “T-Comm” is an automated telephone dialing system that will call all registered home, cell phone, and other phone numbers. When you answer a T-Comm call, it will play a recorded message informing you of the type of emergency, providing essential details, and offering basic guidance on what to do or not do. The call will also advise you to check local emergency broadcasts on television channels or radio stations.

T-Comm messages are solely intended to inform members of an emergency or major disruption affecting Heritage Hunt and are not a substitute for official emergency guidance from official sources such as Prince William County Emergency Management offices. To receive T-Comm emergency notifications, it is imperative that you add the T-Comm number (703) 743-2016 to all your phones as “T-Comm Heritage Hunt” to promptly receive alerts of incidents impacting our community. This is a call you should answer promptly, regardless of the time of day, so ensure the number is easily identifiable and not blocked when your phone is in “Silent Mode.”

Even if you have registered your phone numbers with Heritage Hunt, please notify Janette Nash at lifestyle@heritagehunt.net. If you obtain a new phone number, decide to add additional phone numbers to the HH database, or need to delete an old phone number.

Therefore, when your phone rings and you hear “This is an emergency notification from Heritage Hunt...”, please pay attention. Your prompt response will be greatly appreciated.

Certainly, in the event of an emergency, it is imperative to contact 911 for medical assistance. The Emergency Preparedness Committee (EPC) maintains a robust relationship with our First Responders, fostering annual events such as the Fire Department’s Responders’ brunches that we recently held in March.

We urge residents to be vigilant and prepared for potential accidents involving slips and falls. Additionally, it is essential to familiarize yourself with CPR techniques and the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED). For updates on these training sessions, kindly request information by sending an email to EPCCPR@heritagehunt.net.

For serious traffic accidents, gas leaks, or actual fires, promptly call 911, just as you would for a medical emergency. However, for other emergencies discovered within Heritage Hunt Common Areas, such as a broken pipe causing flooding in the Clubhouse or Mansion, contact the CAMP facility staff during business hours (703-743-2000 ext. 4). In the event of an emergency after business hours, utilize the HOA Common Area Emergency Number by calling the after-hours emergency answering service at 855-477-2267.

GENEALOGY CLUB

The Genealogy Club will meet on Monday, April 28, at 2 PM in the Clubhouse Mt. View Room. We will be treated to a video presentation by well-known genealogist Thomas MacEntee titled, “Translating, Transcribing, and Summarizing Documents Using AI.”

This program is described on MacEntee’s website as: “Learn how to harness the power of artificial intelligence to assist in translating, transcribing, and summarizing a variety of genealogy records,” such as a handwritten baptismal record from the 1800s, a faded newspaper obituary, etc. He also discusses the best AI platforms and how to create a solid prompt to get the results you are looking for.

Genealogy enthusiasts have long been aware that the use of artificial intelligence (AI) would soon jump to the forefront of research techniques, and this program will help to demystify the incorporation of artificial intelligence in our research. Serious researchers who have been “digging up their ancestors” for years are well aware of how much has changed in research techniques in the past 25 years or so and the consequent need for “continuing education.”

For those of you who have never used AI, check out this YouTube video by Lisa Lisson titled “Getting Started: The 3 Free AI Tools I Use for Genealogy Research” at <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Q8oJTK3sDB0>

Another interesting video to watch is <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=LnBKjprPTPo> which describes using ChatGPT in your genealogy research, by Amy Johnson Crow.

A tip for readers of this column who are interested in getting started on researching their family history: visit americanancestors.org/collections/portablegenealogists and explore and perhaps purchase one or more of these very informative genealogy how-to guides, priced at \$10.95 per guide. These guides provide an easy way for anyone (not just those with New England ancestry) who would like to discover and learn about the lives of their ancestors.
